About the Event



The Indiana Academy of Science has supported and participated in Bioblitz events since the early 2000s, with consistent annual events over the past decade. **Each year, approximately 100 scientists, students, and community volunteers come together to document biodiversity across Indiana's natural areas.**

These field-based surveys are a core part of IAS's commitment to community science, bringing together experts and the public to identify and record species while contributing meaningful ecological data for conservation and research.

Bioblitz activities are led by the IAS Biodiversity and Natural Areas Committee (BNAC), a group of specialists in botany, zoology, mycology, and geology. The committee promotes the study of natural history in Indiana through the collection, documentation, and publication of data on the state's biota and natural features. BNAC also plays an important role in advising on the conservation and preservation of Indiana's natural areas, ensuring that the data collected through efforts like the Bioblitz supports long-term environmental stewardship and informed decision-making across the state.
